Academic Achievement	
2016-2019	70% of LKSD students will meet or exceed growth targets on MAP testing
2019-2022	<p style="color: red;">45% of LKSD students will be proficient on the Spring MAP Assessments in Reading, Language, and Math, with a long-term goal of 75%.</p> <p style="color: red;">(Proficient status based on LKSD designation of 40th Percentile) (Schools will continue using Growth measures, shift to Spring to Spring for site-level data and district level) (School-wide specific Proficiency targets to be determined based on benchmark proficiency in Spring 2019)</p>
Attendance Rate	
2016-2019	The LKSD attendance rate will increase to 95% for students in grades K-8 and 91% for students in grades 9-12
2019-2022	<p style="color: red;">The LKSD Chronic Absence rate will decrease to 25% or lower</p> <p style="color: red;">(chronic absence → more than 10% absence rate for all absences; equates to being absent more than 2 days per month or 18 days per year)</p>

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Graduation Rate	
2016-2019	The Four-Year graduation rate for LKSD students will reach 75%
2019-2022	The Four-Year Graduation Rate for LKSD Students will reach 80%
Yugtun and Cugtun Proficiency	
2016-2019	50% of 6 th grade students in LKSD will score within proficiency level 3 or higher on the Yup'ik (Cup'ig) Proficiency Test
2019-2022	75% of LKSD Students* will score within proficiency level 4 or higher on the YPT by 12 th grade *(YPT testing will be administered to all students in DLE/Immersion schools; Students who have completed DLE/Immersion programs will be assessed annually through grade 12) (Staff will continue to focus on YPT growth metrics in all grade levels)
